



## Equity Leaders Action Network – Frequently Asked Questions

### **Applicant Criteria**

Applicants should have responsibility for geographic areas, i.e., county, state, and tribal leaders, as well as community leaders who are responsible for a county. Applicants from both inside and outside of government are welcome.

Multiple individuals from the same organization may apply, but they may not apply as a group. Selections will be made based on individual applications. In addition, multiple applicants from a single state or location are encouraged to apply. Two-three individuals from a jurisdiction may be considered.

### **Time Commitment and Travel Requirements**

Network members will be expected to attend at least one national two-three day meeting each year and at least one full-day regional meeting each year. They also will be expected to participate in quarterly webinars and implementation work on specific projects over the three years with colleagues around the country. The national meeting likely will require travel.

### **Fees and Financial Support**

There are no fees associated with the opportunity; however, if accepted and you make arrangements and are unable to participate, you may be required to reimburse BUILD. Also, it is hoped that learning from the network can be implemented within existing resources in your scope of work. Most costs, including transportation and housing to attend required meetings, will be covered.
