

## System Collaboration Logic Model Vision and Goals

**Vision** Optimally, a comprehensive system collaboration will:

- Reach all children and families, and as early as possible, with needed services and supports
- Genuinely include and effectively accommodate children with special needs
- Reflect and respect the strengths, needs, values, languages, cultures and communities of children and families
- Ensure stability and continuity of services along a continuum from prenatal into school entry and beyond
- Ease access for families and transitions for children
- Value parents as decision makers and leaders
- Catalyze and maximize investment and foster innovation

**Goal 1:** The community has a coordinated and collaborative system of services focusing on children from birth to five years (maternal and child health, early childhood, social and human services, school based, etc)

**Goal 2:** Families have access to needed and appropriate services that are responsive to their needs.

**Goal 3:** The collaborative system is comprised of a skilled workforce.

**Goal 4:** Services within the coordinated and collaborative system are family focused, culturally competent and strengths based.

**Goal 5:** Families are leaders in their community and the collaborative system.
